- 2. The subject of the auction will be auctioned subject to our auction conditions and the following conditions.
- 3. The auctioneer, also invoice issuer, receives a processing fee for carrying out the auction, valuing, assessing and cataloging the subject of the auction (called "the vehicle" in the following), which is determined as follows:

Cars/Motorbikes: per vehicle/motorbike from 199.00 EUR (incl. 19% MwSt)
For 3 or more vehicles/motorbikes from 189.00 EUR per vehicle/motorbike (incl. 19% MwSt)

Preconditions for the 199.00 EUR price: The vehicle/motorbike must be clean inside and outside. We receive meaningful, detailed photos (at least 15 good photos as .jpg) for the catalogue and internet side at least 3 weeks before the auction date. The vehicle must be delivered 1 day before the exhibition/auction and collected again at the end of the exhibition/auction by the seller.

If desired, your vehicle and the report/description of the condition, can be prepared by independent experts. We are happy to do this for you; the work will be charged according to the time and effort involved.

Unless otherwise stated, the processing fees are stated net and are subject to additional, statutory value added tax, currently 19%.

No processing fees (delivery fees) are charged for Automobilia. Precondition for this is delivery and collection by the seller, photos and description in digital form must be provided at least 3 weeks before the auction (at least 5 good photos as .jpg).

The auctioneer's commission for Automobilia is 9.95 % of the hammer price plus statutory value added tax, currently 19%. This also applies if the seller auctions the item(s) himself.



4. The auctioneer receives a commission. For an auctioned object with a net hammer price of
- up to € 25,000.-- 9.95% of the highest bid
 - over € 25,000.-- 7.95% of the highest bid
- The commissions are subject to statutory value added tax, currently 19%.
5. Objects delivered for auction are not insured by the auction house, all liability is expressly excluded. This does not apply to damage to/loss of the auction item if this is caused deliberately or by gross negligence on the part of our employees or agents.
6. The seller undertakes that he is the owner of the item delivered for auction. He further guarantees that, to his knowledge, the items delivered for auction have not been acquired unlawfully and are not subject to third-party rights (pledged, assigned as collateral). He accepts liability for the accuracy of his statement.
7. If the item to be auctioned is withdrawn before the auction, the auctioneer has the right to 6% of the limit price, minimum € 500.--. The resulting amount, respectively the minimum amount, is due and owed within 10 days of the close of the auction.
8. Hammer prices under € 500.00 will be settled within 4 weeks from the end of the auction, higher amounts will be settled up to 50%, the balance 8 weeks after the end of the auction at the latest.
9. The seller is liable for defects in the objects which he delivers for auction.
10. The vehicle must be handed over at the event location by 10 a.m. on the day before the auction, at the latest. An appointment must be made with the organizer in good time.
11. Vehicles which are not sold must be collected at the end of the event (exhibition Sunday, about 5p.m.). From this point, the seller is no longer bound by the contract. If the vehicle is not collected within this time limit, the auctioneer/organizer has the right to charge a storage fee of at least € 30.00 per day, plus statutory value added tax, currently 19%.
